The 2017 Executive Leadership Institute will provide cutting-edge information about evidence-based decisions to improve classrooms and schools. Presenters are from Behavioral Research and Teaching (BRT) in the College of Education. Researchers at BRT developed easyCBM, an assessment system for districts and classroom teachers, and Response to Intervention (RTI). Approaches to both behavioral and academic decision-making will be presented, along with opportunities to learn from experts who currently engage in actions related to the presentations.
